

2006 CODE AMENDMENT STEERING COMMITTEE REPORT

Meeting notes from June 13th, 2007:

1: *Approve May 24th meeting notes.*

The approval of the meeting notes from the May 24th meeting was deferred until the committee could review them.

2: *Presentation of eEditor by Deborah Galey-Tucker from ICC*

A presentation of the ICC's software for converting amendments into an electronic file capable of being shared by the Internet was demonstrated.

3: *Vote on revised amendments.*

IBC-S4A was reviewed and approved as revised at the May 24th meeting.

Outstanding amendments are IBC-S2, IBC-S10, IBC-S11, UPC-19, UMC-4, UMC-9, UMC-13 and IECC/IRC-13. The technical committee headed by Dale Gillaspay is addressing the minimum required plumbing fixtures conflict between the IBC and UMC.

4: *Packaging of amendments.*

The issue of how to present the amendments so that they were in acceptable legal adoption form was not resolved due to the variations required by the legal staff of the jurisdictions involved. The amendment package will be assembled as presented to the steering committee. It was brought up that a letter of support recommending the adoption of the amendment package will be drafted and forwarded to the appropriate political bodies. A list of participants from each sub committee is needed to include on the statement. The steering committee should be present for the code adoption process at every jurisdiction.

5: *Set next steering committee date if necessary.*

The next meeting was set for June 27th at 1:00.
