

## 2006 CODE AMENDMENT STEERING COMMITTEE REPORT

Meeting notes from June 27th, 2007:

**1: Approve June 13th meeting notes. Distribute revised May 24<sup>th</sup> meeting notes.**

The June 13th meeting notes were approved without modifications. The revised May 24<sup>th</sup> meeting notes were approved without further revisions.

**2: IBC-S2 (Wind Designation), IBC-S10 (Patio Cover Footings) and IBC-S11 (Footing and Stem Wall Table).**

IBC-S2	<i>Passed</i> as originally proposed.
IBC-S10R	<i>Passed</i> as revised. This amendment was not proposed by the sub committee. It was included to show the sub committee had considered past amendments. The steering committee wanted some relief for small unenclosed patio covers.
IRC-AH106.1	<i>Passed-unanimous.</i> This was a companion document to IBC-S10R.
IBC-S11	<i>Tabled.</i> This was another amendment not proposed by the sub committee. The steering committee wanted some prescriptive language to allow non engineered structures to excavate the ground under the floor to the bottom of the footing. It was decided to leave the IBC without an amendment and to pursue this with an IRC amendment to section 403.

**3: UPC-19R (Manometer Testing).**

UPC-19R	<i>Passed-6 for/1 abstain</i> as revised with City of Fernley an additional tester and language added to not require a manometer when the serving utility performs a manometer test.
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**4: UMC-4R (Replacment Air), UMC-9R (CSST Tables) and UMC-13R (Dryer Vent).**

UMC-4R	<i>Passed-7 for/1 abstain</i> as revised with exception 2 unmodified.
UMC-9R	<i>Passed-6 for/2 abstain</i> as revised. The direction after the May 24 <sup>th</sup> meeting was to insert the "I" Code language into the UMC.
UMC-13R	<i>Failed. 7 for/1 against.</i> The direction after the May 24 <sup>th</sup> meeting was to insert the "I" Code language into the UMC. After discussion it was decided that UMC section 1317.3 gave the authority to accept the manufacturer's tables when determined by standard engineering practice.

**5: *IECC/IRC-13R (Underfloor Ventilation).***

*Passed / unanimous* as revised with exception 1 removed from the original amendment. It was noted that the IECC and chapter 11 of the IRC may need to be amended also to allow exception 2.

**6: *Conflict between UMC and IBC corridor return air.***

An amendment had been prepared by one of the Mechanical sub committee members to resolve the conflict. The amendment as written did not adequately address the conflict and the amendment was returned for additional work.

**7: *Minimum required plumbing fixtures (Dale Gillaspay).***

Dale reported that a comparison table between the two codes had not been completed to date. The suggestions from the technical advisory committee were to use the IBC tables and limit the requirement for drinking fountains to an occupancy load, such as 30. The other suggestion was to allow a central mop sink for some occupancies. Dale will present a more detailed suggestion at the next meeting.

**8: *Appendices***

It was decided that the package should include only the minimum number of appendices. It was noted that any appendices that are to be amended should be accomplished under the multi-jurisdictional process.27<sup>th</sup> for your approval

**9: *Statement of support and recommendation of amendment package to political bodies.***

It was decided that a group statement would be too hard to frame in a meeting. Since the moderator had started a statement, the committee will review the statement at the next meeting.

**10: *Set the next steering committee meeting date.***

The next steering committee meeting was set for July 11<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am.
